TENTATIVE UN-Habitat Evaluation Plan for 2016-2017

Introduction

The evaluation function in UN-Habitat works to strengthen its evaluation culture through targeted evaluation activities by enhancing quality, scope and coverage of evaluations in support of organizational learning, programme improvement and accountability at all levels of the agency.

UN-Habitat's evaluation function has improved through the creation of the Evaluation Unit in 2012, adoption of the evaluation policy in 2013 and institutionalization of evaluation management responses and follow-up on recommendations from evaluations. In 2015, the *Revised UN-Habitat Evaluation Framework* was adopted to increase evaluation coverage, assess projects at risk and improve procedures for planning and costing of evaluation in projects. The framework comes with four performance targets: 1) 100% of projects of value US\$1 million and above is evaluated; 2) 10% of projects of value US\$1-1,000,000 is evaluated; 3) At least one country programme evaluation for each 2 year Programme of Work in each of the four regions; and 4) Two corporate evaluations are conducted per year.

Priority-setting of the Evaluation Plan

According to the *UN-Habitat Evaluation Policy* (2013), the purpose of the Evaluation Plan is to prioritize and plan for evaluations to be conducted by UN-Habitat as well as other evaluation activities. Main types of evaluations conducted are evaluations of projects and programmes, country programme evaluations, evaluations of (or related to) the Strategic Plan, and impact evaluations. The evaluation plan is prepared by the Evaluation Unit, who is designated with the overall responsibility for evaluation activities. The plan is updated on an annual basis and subject to approval by the UN-Habitat Board. The evaluation plan (attached) is the draft version for further consultation with management.

The biennial plan is developed using a priority-setting model and benchmarks for identifying topics to be evaluated. The revised evaluation framework requires that all projects of US\$1 million and above have an end-of-project evaluation. For projects below US\$1 million, end-of-project evaluation or self-evaluation is conducted. Few projects are under US\$300,000 and evaluation is not required in such cases. Corporate evaluations are decided by management based on risk assessment.

Evaluation priorities for 2016-2017

The evaluation plan for 2016-2017 represents UN-Habitat's work at global level, in all its four regions, and at country level. Specifically, the following evaluations will be prioritized:

- Global initiatives: Achieving Sustainable Urban Development (ASUD); and Global Land Tool Network (GLTN) II, Participatory Slum Upgrading Programme (PSUP) II.
- Country level performance: Jordan, Lebanon, Egypt, Kuwait, Morocco, Palestine, DRC, Somalia, Sri Lanka (TBC).
- Normative work: Evaluation of the City Planning component (SEA2.2) of FA2.
- Contribution to MDGs/SDGs: Participatory Slum Upgrading Programme (PSUP) II, end-of-project evaluation.
- Evaluation of the Strategic Plan, including cross-cutting issues: Evaluability Study of the Strategic Plan, UN-Habitat Youth Programme; and the Gender Equality Unit.
- Strategic corporate management: Regional Office for Arab States; Cooperation Agreement between UN-Habitat and Sweden, 2012-2015.
- Thematic evaluations: Youth Empowerment for urban development and Gender Equity Programme

The evaluations will be managed by the Evaluation Unit (centralized evaluations) and providing quality assurance based on the UNEG Norms and Standards in Evaluation. Other evaluations (decentralized evaluations) will be managed by the project manager with technical support of the Evaluation Unit. Evaluations may also be managed by the donor, as it is the case of final evaluation of the Participatory Slum Upgrading Programme II by the European Union.

Looking Forward

Looking forward, evaluation focus and priorities during the biennium will be centered on:

- Developing and implementing quality and responsive evaluations, managing centralized and supporting decentralized evaluations of UN-Habitat interventions;
- Assessing programme outcomes and impacts of long term programmes of strategic importance for the New Urban Agenda; and
- Raising awareness and building capacity for use of evaluations for informed decision-making, effective programme delivery and resource mobilization.
